Please stop by for a permit at 7240 SW Philomath Blvd prior to any riding in the area for the Tum Tum Unit. A 400.00 fine will be issued if you are asked for a permit and do not have one while recreating. The Permits are free and for your safety as logging activity and occasional spraying can occur and Starker Forests would like to inform you of any of these safety issues during the year.

Q & A

Where is the Mudslinger

17 miles west of Corvallis off of HWY 20. To get there take HWY 34 off of I-5 into Corvallis and head West through Philomath and continue onto HWY 20 towards Newport and take a left hand turn off of the HWY just past the Blodgett country store. The event is at the Blodgett School. Parking is stretched out so come early and please do not block driveways and be aware of the neighbors and the special use that we have in using this area and land associated.

Can I pre-ride the course?

Yes if you have a free permit from Starker Forests at 7200 SW Philomath BLVD. They want to know who is on their land incase they have a closure and or a spraying in progress. The fine is 400.00 if you do not have a permit and that could buy some wheels or something.

Can I camp?

Yes, 5 minutes west on HWY 20 is the Blodgett Café/Area to pitch a tent/RV, no hook ups. Please E-mail me to reserve.

Where can I eat the morning of?

In Corvallis the Beanery or Starbucks is open for a quick am pick me up

Important reminder

Pack it out! This means your gel wrappers and or food wrappers and leave no trace. You will be DQ'd if found to dropping something while racing and not making the effort. It matters

Where can I pick up my swag bag and plate?

The night before at Peak Sports from 2-4 pm at 135 NW 2nd and the morning of from 7-9am in the gym. Please do not be late

I do not have an OBRA one-day license?

Its 5.00 and supports the Oregon Bicycle Racing Association and you can add it to your fee

I am new to this kind of thing and do not know what category to enter?

Enter the Cat 3 class if you want to give it a shot and get your feet wet. If you are a fit person looking for a challenge, enter the cat 2 category and your age group. Most of all have fun

Are there showers?

No, we have a fire truck to wash your bikes and please bring a bucket with some fresh water and towel to clean up.

What are at the aide stations:

Bread, peanut butter, jam, Hammer Nutrition Products including and HEED Electrolyte drink and lots of water

Is beer allowed?

Not on the school premises, please be aware that you will be DNF'd if you have a beer on the school premises.....sorry

How does the race Start

The race starts from the school (Mass Start) and I will lead you out, .25 miles down a county rd to the start. From there I will stage your group by ability. Pro Men, Cat 1 Men, Pro/Cat 1 Women, Singlespeed, Cat 2 , ect.....this will be posted on my site. The usual gap is 2 minutes between fields.

Where do we finish the race?

At the Blodgett School. Get to the bike wash right after you finish to clean up

Awards and raffle

Food will be served starting at noon, pasta and bread from Great Harvest of Corvallis Oregon (Thanks Travis and Michelle) at the school and awards will be at 11:30
